

ORKNEY INTER-ISLES AIR SERVICE SIGHTSEER INFORMATION SUMMER 2012

Loganair, Scotland's Airline, operates regular scheduled flights linking Kirkwall with six of the Orkney Islands. The flights are supported by the Orkney Islands Council and are an integral part of the islands' transport network, carrying over 20,000 passengers every year including island residents, tourists, the Royal Bank of Scotland's "Flying Banker", peripatetic teachers and many others besides!

The flight between Westray and Papa Westray is listed by Guinness World Records as the world's shortest scheduled flight. From take-off to touchdown, the two-minute flight covers a distance less than that of the main runway at Edinburgh. The unique service is an attraction in its own right, and passengers on our sightseeing trips receive a special certificate signed by the Captain and a miniature of Orkney's very own *Highland Park* whisky to commemorate their trip.


Up to now, it has only been possible to book a sightseer trip on the day of the flight. In Summer 2010, Loganair is adding extra sightseer flights which can be booked in advance. Visitors can now guarantee that, weather permitting, their trip to the Orkney Islands can include a fantastic sightseeing trip taking in the world's shortest scheduled flight.

Advance sightseer reservations will be available on special flights on Tuesdays and Thursdays between 14 June and 30 August 2012. The flights leave Kirkwall at 11:45 and take around 45 minutes to complete the full journey including landings at Westray and Papa Westray. The sightseer fare from Kirkwall is £39.00 return including all taxes.
